**Secretary's Report:**

**Approval of September 15 Minutes:** Steve Wallace was not present- the roll call vote needs to be amended. John Leavit made a motion to accept the minutes. 2nd by Jon Pinette.

**Treasurer's Report:** Current balance is \$34,729.87

Steve Wallace revisited the inspector pay that Chairman Guild tabled from the last fight. According to our regulations-for more than 5 hours the inspectors are supposed to earn an additional \$15. According to this rule, the 14 inspectors are

due an additional \$45 from the last show. Going forward, we need to make sure this rule is being followed. The Authority is responsible for the number of inspectors working each show. We need to be looking forward to an inspector training. During discussion- Nick DiSalvo from NEF said he needs to be aware of the total amount due at the end of the event and asked clarifying questions regarding hiring staff and does that include Inspectors.

We need to look into the billing for the AAG's office, and authority members looking to take their pay. Jon Pinette made a motion to accept the report. 2nd by John Leavitt.

**Updates from AAG:** Muay Thai rules update- there is one more form that needs to be filled out and processed. Then they will be filed with the Secretary Of State on paper and electronically. This will initiate the public notice for the public comment period of 30 days. There may be a need for a public hearing, but it may not which would then move us onto the next step. Matt Peterson of NEF Fights asked if they could potentially plan for Muay Thai bouts on the February 7 card. AAG Dow said it would be possible, but could potentially be very tight for planning for February.

Can members of the Authority compete? The short answer is yes. Obviously there could be potential personal conflicts of interest which would require the member to recuse themselves from voting.

### **Old Business:**

**NEF Fight Card Review:** The Fight Card for NEF Call to Arms on 11/8 was sent for review. Steve Wallace questioned the Devin Corson fight- his record is 0-0 vs a 9-2. His amateur career was very impressive. He has not lost a fight in 6 years. He works at a facility that is respected and has good coaches. Each competitor has their own strengths that they bring to the fight and has the potential to be a very impressive fight.

John Leavitt asked about the Ed Davis fight. His opponent has taken a lot of fights that he probably shouldn't have taken on short notice. He has fought multiple UFC fighters. He is a much better fighter than his record appears and it will probably be

a challenging fight for Ed Davis. Jon Pinette raised concerns that he has not won since 2022 and is 41 years old. Matt revisited his history and his training.
